HELPFUL HINTS

You must submit your FAFSA including other documentation as requested AND be accepted for admission by **March 2, 2009** to be considered for campus based federal funds.

FAFSA ON THE WEB

- Fill out a **2009-10 FAFSA on the Web Worksheet**
- Student and parents obtain a **FAFSA PIN** at www.fafsa.ed.gov
- Using the **Worksheet**, complete the **2009-10 FAFSA on the Web** www.fafsa.ed.gov
- Use your **legal name** as it appears on your Social Security Card.
- Submit your FAFSA as soon as possible **after January 1, 2009** and prior to March 2, 2009.
- Print or write down your FAFSA Confirmation Stamp received upon submission.
- Mail signature page if required. Follow instructions carefully.

If you do not receive an email response to retrieve your Student Aid Report (SAR) electronically within 7 days, call the Federal Student Aid Information Center at 1-800-433-3243.

PAPER FAFSA Paper FAFSAs can be obtained by calling 1-800-433-3243

- Sign, date and mail your 2009-10 FAFSA form in the envelope provided **after** January 1, 2009 and **prior** to March 2, 2009.
- Obtain a Certificate of Mailing from the Post Office.

If you do not receive your Student Aid Report (SAR) within 2 weeks, call the Federal Student Aid Information Center at 1-800-433-3243.

Additional documentation may be requested. Submit any requested documentation to the CalArts Office of Financial Aid. All students must submit a copy of their and/or their parents 2008 IRS return no later than June 1, 2009. Students/Parents not filing a 2008 return must complete and submit a 2009/2010 Certificate of Non-Income Tax Filing.

UNDERGRADUATE CALIFORNIA RESIDENTS ONLY - Additional Requirements for CalGrant

In addition to the FAFSA postmarked no later than **March 2, 2009** you must submit a GPA Verification certified by your last school of attendance to the California Student Aid Commission (CSAC) by **March 2, 2009**. **Note: CalArts students must request their GPA directly from the Registrar by February 15, 2009.**
